Fred was scalded by boiling water when he was very young. The water was being boiled for laundry in the Hotel. He was burned quite badly down one of his legs, causing scar tissue that made his leg a bit crooked. This caused him to always walk with a limp. He did not allow this disability to affect his way of life.
